

The Gray County Board of Commissioners met to Reorganize for the 2010 Year on Monday, January 11, 2010, with Mark E. Busch, Glenn Oyler, David L. Loucks and Bonnie Swartz, County Clerk, attending.

Kirk Anderson entered the meeting.

The problems with the heating and air conditioning system were discussed. Bonnie was authorized to contract with a company to find where the problem is.

Mark E. Busch was elected to serve as chairman during 2010. Authorization was given for any of the commissioners to sign county warrants when the situation requires it.

Personnel Rules and Regulations were reviewed and established. The resolution is on file.

The Depositories for the county were reaffirmed for 2010. The resolution is on file.

Salaries for 2010 were discussed. Department heads may give wage increases up to the percentage of increase over last year's wage rates to employees on their annual anniversary date, after an employee evaluation has been given, based on the following:

Employees with hourly rates of pay \$13.00 or less – 3%
Employees with hourly rates of pay between \$13.01 and \$14.00 – 2%
Employees with hourly rates of pay between \$14.01 and \$15.00 – 1%
Employees with hourly rates of pay \$15.01 or more – 0%

The Montezuma Press was designated as the official newspaper for 2010, however, all legal notices are to be published in the Jacksonian as well, with the full allowed rate being split equally between the two newspapers.
