The minutes of the previous meeting were read, corrected, and approved.

Jim Kennedy, Kennedy McKee & Company entered the meeting at 10:00 a.m. He presented the 2021 audit report and discussed it with the commissioners. He also discussed the 2023 county budget.

Sean Wendel entered the meeting at 11:20 p.m. He presented (3) road crossing permits which were approved. He then discussed the bridge projects.

Sean also discussed starting wages for his department. He said the State has raised their starting wages. Decision was made to change the starting wages at road & bridge to \$15.50 without a CDL and \$17.50 with a CDL.

Health Insurance was then discussed. Decision was made to add a 60-day waiting period to all new employee's health insurance. The county will offer a \$1,000.00 insurance stipend to those full-time employees that elect the health insurance. This will help them pay for other coverage until the waiting period is up.
