Jeff assured the commission that the monitor in records is just for an extra set of eyes to help monitor for any security issues.

Sean Wendel and John Riggins entered the meeting at 10:30 a.m. They discussed a traffic study that was done on V Road. He also discussed the progress on the bridge projects.

Sean presented an Agreement with Koss Construction for the purchase of millings in the future. The price will be \$6.00 per ton. Commissioners approved the price and signed the agreement.

Sean then discussed hiring a mechanic and the starting wages.

John discussed the HRRR project. John also presented the Agreement for Engineering Services for the 2023 Chip Seal in the amount of \$4,750.00. Commissioners signed the agreement.
